ADVENTURER SONG



Please say the Adventurer Law with me as I say it aloud (read it). Now, let's say the Adventurer Pledge together (read it). Great job.

Now, let's sing our Adventurer song together (play the video, mute yourself, be visibly singing). Isn't that a great song!

Next, let's have prayer. When we pray, we are talking to Jesus who lives in heaven. To show that we love Jesus very much, we fold our hands and close our eyes when we pray. Can you do that with me now? Let's all fold our hands, like this (demonstrate) and close our eyes like this (demonstrate). *Say a prayer.* Thank you for praying with me. Jesus loves you so much! Next we are going to spend a few minutes learning about Jesus! (*next slide*)

LEARN ABOUT JESUS



Hi, my name is _____. Let's spend a little time learning more about Jesus together. I have a question for you. "How many of you have ever seen a butterfly... in real life?" Raise your hand if you have. That's wonderful! I love butterflies. They are so beautiful and detailed and delicate. Raise your hand if you know who made the butterflies? (call on a kid, let them unmute and answer - answer: Jesus). That's right. Jesus made the butterflies special! I have another question, "Did you know that Jesus made you special?" Jesus like the beautiful butterflies, Jesus made you with special details and beauty also! Today we are going to learn a song about butterflies and how Jesus made us special! *(next slide)*



Let's learn this song together. The words to the song will be on the screen, and you just might recognize it anyway. So, sing along with me! (encourage kids to sing, especially on the chorus which repeats and they may recognize) Wasn't that a fun song! On the count of three I want you to put your arms up in the air and say, nice and loud, "God made me special." Ok ready? One, two, three. (raise arms) God made me special! (*next slide*)




The Bible tells us what it is: “See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!” (1 John 3:1). That means that God loves us so much that when we love Him in return, His love changes us to be like Jesus. That reminds me of today’s message: **GOD’S LOVE CHANGES US!** *(next slide)*

STORY TIME

Crickets chirped in the grass. Night birds sang. Quietly, Nicodemus walked toward the place where he had been told that he could find Jesus.(next slide)



When he found Jesus, Nicodemus said, “Teacher, we know You came from God! Your miracles tell everybody that You are from Him!” Jesus smiled in the darkness. He knew that Nicodemus really wanted to believe in Him. But Nicodemus was an important Pharisee, and he was having a hard time believing that Jesus could really be God’s Son. So Jesus looked steadily at him and said, “Nicodemus, miracles are not the most important thing! Unless you are born again, you will not see God’s kingdom.” *(next slide)*



“Born again? What does that mean? How can I go back inside of my mother? I’m a grown man!” Nicodemus exclaimed. “You’re right, my friend,” Jesus replied. “But I’m not talking about being born physically. I’m talking about being born spiritually. Truthfully, Nicodemus, unless you are reborn by God’s Holy Spirit, you can’t be part of God’s kingdom.” “I’m not sure I understand,” Nicodemus said thoughtfully. *(next slide)*



“Think about the wind for a moment,” Jesus replied. “You can’t see the wind itself, but you can see what happens when the wind blows. You can see the treetops sway and hear the rustling of the leaves. When the Holy Spirit comes into a person’s life, it’s like that. You can’t see the time when a person’s life is changed, but you see what happens in their life because their heart—their mind—is new and clean.” It was quiet while Nicodemus thought about what Jesus was saying. *(next slide)*



“Nicodemus, your physical life came from your parents, but a person’s spiritual life comes from the Holy Spirit,” Jesus continued. “When a person chooses to let God come into his or her life, God helps them change their ugly, sinful mind, and gives the person a brand-new one. That’s being born again. *(next slide)*”



“Nicodemus, I have good news for you! God loves the world so much that He sent His only Son here, so that whenever someone believes in Him, God can give them that brand-new life! And that new life means they are born again! They will have the gift of eternal life!”(next slide)



Nicodemus learned something that night that everyone must learn. Jesus loves us so much! He is ready right now to take our ugly, sinful minds and lives and give us brand-new ones! Will you let Him give you that new, clean life today? Will you be God's child? Will you be born again and take the present of eternal life that He wants to give you? Let's say a prayer. (say a short prayer asking each child to give their heart to Jesus) (*next slide*)

LEARNING TIME



Hi, my name is _____. Today we are going to learn about the life cycle of a butterfly. *(next slide)*

Life Cycle of a Butterfly



Open your activity packet and find the paper that says “Life Cycle of a Butterfly.” <https://www.teacherspayteachers.com/Product/Butterfly-Life-Cycle-Cut-and-Paste-Worksheet-1850253> You will need a pair of scissors and a glue stick or tape. Right now I'd like you to cut off the 5 pictures from the bottom of your page. Each of these pictures represents a part of the butterfly's life cycle. As we watch the video, I'd like you to try and arrange them in the correct order. (pause and wait for everyone to cut out the pictures, check that everyone is ready) Ok, now lets watch the video. Remember, try to put the pictures in the correct order to show the butterfly life cycle. (play the video). Wasn't that an interesting video! Did you get all your pictures in order? Lets check them together. First, a butterfly lays eggs on the leaf of a plant (hold up egg picture) Let's put that on #1. Next, eggs hatch into larvae or caterpillars (hold up that picture). Lets put that on #2. Next, the caterpillar becomes a pupa and forms into a chrysalis. (hold up that picture). Lets put that on #3. Next, after 15 days and alot of changes, an adult butterfly emerges from the chrysalis (hold up that picture). Lets put that on #4. Next, after a few hours the wings fully expand and dry and the butterfly can fly. (hold up that picture) Lets put that on #5. Then the whole cycle begins again. Just like a butterfly goes through a cycle for new butterflies to emerge. We can also accept Jesus into our hearts and emerge new. This is what Jesus was talking about when he met with Nicodemus in the Bible story we heard today. *(next slide)*

CRAFT TIME



Hi everyone, my name is _____. It's time to do a craft. Please get out your activity packet. You will need your butterfly craft kit. (explain how to do the craft - peeling off the glitter stickers and placing them on the correct color dots on the butterfly). Do you see what your butterfly craft says? It says "Jesus brings new life!" Just like the cycle of the butterfly brings new life - new butterflies, Jesus can make you brand new if you accept him into your heart. Would you like to accept Jesus into your heart today and let him make you brand new? Give me a thumbs up if you'd like to say with me, "I love Jesus!". Awesome! Thank you for doing a craft with me. (*next slide*).
