

Pathfinder Club COVID-19 Response Plan



Safety Always First

Safety is our top priority. The staff of the Pathfinder club are committed to doing everything in our power to keep your child(ren) safe. We intend to err on the side of caution. We will continue to monitor, adjust, and follow all guidelines as set forth by the CDC, local government, and the SDA conference.



Attendance Expectations

Please do not attend a Pathfinder function if

- You are diagnosed with COVID-19, you have COVID-19 type symptoms, you are sick with another illness, you are running a fever, or if you are not feeling well.
- You are exposed to someone with COVID-19 or someone who is being tested for COVID-19.
- You are exposed to someone who has the flu, is sick, or is running a fever.
- You have traveled out of your normal routine or if someone has traveled to you outside of your normal routine in the past 14 days. (Please disclose travel and we will evaluate case by case.)

Please quarantine from Pathfinders for 14 days as needed or instructed by a doctor before returning. **Please help us keep everyone safe by erring on the side of caution in this matter.**



Social Distancing

During official Pathfinder functions, you may not be within 6 feet of someone who is not in your family unit. This applies even if you have spent time with another club member outside of official Pathfinder time. This also applies to anyone who is your relative, but outside of your family unit. Please refrain from touching of any kind.



Masks

Masks will be required during any indoor activity or outdoor activities where social distancing can not be maintained. If a club member is struggling to maintain the 6 feet of social distance, they will be given a mask to wear. Please cover your nose & mouth.



Meetings

Pathfinder functions will be scheduled outdoors as much as possible. In the event of inclement weather, the club director and deputies will assess risk & circumstances to determine if the event will be canceled or moved indoors & possibly shortened. If an event is scheduled or moved indoors, the largest available space will be used and club members will be grouped by family unit or small group, social distancing will be monitored, and masks will be required.



Check In Procedure

When you arrive at a Pathfinder event or meeting, please remain in your car. A Pathfinder staff safety officer, wearing a neon vest, will come to your car to ask screening questions, take your child's temperature, offer hand sanitizer, and make sure they have their materials. Please do not get out of the car and join the group until cleared by the staff safety officer. If by chance you do not see the safety officer when you arrive, text the club director to let us know you have arrived.



Supplies

No supplies will be shared.

Each club member will be issued a supply pack of things to use. Please bring this pack to every meeting & event. If new or additional supplies are needed, they will be distributed and not taken back. Each club member will need to bring their own chair to every meeting & event. If you don't have a chair, the club will issue you one that you will take home and bring back each time.



Food

No food or drinks will be served or provided. Please do not bring your own food to a Pathfinder function unless it crosses a meal time and you have been specifically instructed to do so. Please do not utilize the water fountain in the church facility. Please bring your own water bottle. Be mindful that most public water fountain facilities are closed at this time.



Restrooms

Please use the restroom before you come to a Pathfinder event. Most restrooms at outdoor venues are closed to public use. Restrooms at the church facility are for true emergencies only and will require sanitation after each individual use by a staff attendant.



Sanitizing

We encourage club members to wash their hands frequently. We will provide opportunities for this. Hand sanitizer use will be encouraged. Sanitizing sprays & wipes will be available at all Pathfinder functions.



Transportation

Vehicle passengers should all be from the same family unit. Parents will need to bring their own child(ren) to the location of the scheduled event. In the case that transportation for a Pathfinder is needed, which means that members from different family units would be together in the same vehicle, parents of both families will need to give permission and all persons will be required to wear a mask while in the vehicle together.



Visitors / Non-Club Members

We respectfully ask that non-Pathfinder members & non-staff persons, such as parents, spouses, and siblings, not attend any Pathfinder functions. This will help us adhere to social distancing requirements, limited occupancy requirements, limit the exposure pool, and help with any potential contact tracing.

We will deal with exceptions case-by-case.
